DESCRIPTION

The **89.5 The Hawk Second Year Post Secondary Music Scholarship** was created in 2009 in conjunction with the return of CHWK FM to Chilliwack, BC in the form of 89.5 The Hawk and is an annual competitive award for students enrolling in their second year of post secondary music studies.

PURPOSE

The two awards of \$1,500.00 shall be awarded to students who demonstrate high academic achievement, display active involvement and leadership within their current post-secondary music program and plan to continue to their studies in order to prepare for a professional career in music.

CRITERIA and ELIGIBILITY

The **89.5 The Hawk Second Year Post Secondary Music Scholarship** will be awarded to a student(s) that:

- a) Is pursuing their second year of post-secondary music studies in any instrument or area including music business, music recording, music education, music performance and music therapy with an accredited institution
- b) Has been accepted by a college or university for study in the upcoming academic year
- c) Resided or is residing within the boundaries of the Chilliwack School District
- d) Completed or will be completing a full year credit load in a post-secondary music program with an accredited institution
- e) Demonstrates involvement and leadership within their current post-secondary music program
- f) Is under 25 years of age at the time of application
- g) Completes a personal interview (if required)

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- a) Application deadline is **4:30 p.m. April 1** of each year. (If the 1st falls on a weekend, the application is due the following Monday)
- b) No late or incomplete applications will be considered. No exceptions.
- c) Application forms are available on the Chilliwack Academy of Music website or through your high school
- d) Scholarship applications must be submitted to:

ADJUDICATION

- a) A selection committee will be comprised of the Chilliwack Academy of Music Principal and the Radio CHWK Station Manager
- b) Selection shall be based on the criteria listed above
- c) Involvement and leadership within applicants current post-secondary music program is especially important in the decision
- d) If no candidates are judged to be of sufficient calibre for an award, no awards will be given
- e) The decision of the committee is final

NOTIFICATION OF AWARDS

All candidates will receive written notification of their results by May 1.

PAYMENT OF THE AWARD

According to Canada Revenue Agency guidelines, the award must be paid by the Chilliwack Academy of Music directly to the university or college and will be made after September 15 once the recipient has provided proof of registration in an accredited post-secondary music program.
